## MESSAGE FROM THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR

love & hope foundation canada (lhfc) was established in 2017 to help people by providing grant for basic education, medical educational, vocational service, water and sanitation, winter clothes distribution, Journalist Award, etc.

In the following year we have added grants for basic health care, mother and child health care, Disability, Disease prevention and treatment, economic development and Environment.

This current year we will run twelve avenues of services, they are January - vocational service: providing sewing machine and computer, February - recognising people: who improve quality of lives, March - water and sanitation: clean water supply and setup sanitary toilet, April - environment: tree plantation, May - medical education: providing grant for an international talent, June - basic health care: supply health and hygiene materials, July - maternal and child health: baby food supply, August - disability: provide wheel chair, September - basic education: provide computer for school and school supplies, October - community and economic development: donate goats and cows among poor people, November – winter clothes distribution, December - disease prevention and treatment: mosquito net distribution and cataract surgery and health camp.

We have implemented 83% of our proposed projects and we have sent 100% of the donation money to the people in need around the world. We honor our sponsors Bony Abraham, Kausar Moni, Kazi Hossain Alam, Mahbub Osmani, Mohammed Hassan Monjur Chowdhury, Mozammel Hoque, Omar Hasan Al Zahid, Zamal Hossain for coming forward to alleviate poverty and improve lifestyle for people in need.

We have a small volunteer team to serve our local community. We are providing free English languages classes on every Sunday from 12:00 to 2:00 pm. Our volunteers are also offering online English language classes for students of grade 3, 4 and 5 in non-English speaking countries in Asia.

Our charity activities are inspiring our local businesses and they are becoming our partner. It indicates that the expansion, awareness, awakening and connecting to the generosity of our community leaders and businesses. This collaboration also inspiring us to do better and we are committed to excellence and dedicated to innovation with full transparency.

Our vision is to be a charity of choice in global community and a leader in humanity that allows the mission and vision of lhfc to change lives and bring smiles for people in need.

	<p>4. As part of promotion and public awareness we have participated in three big Community Festival in Toronto. One in 6th Bangladesh Festival, another one in Bangladesh Street Festival Toronto and other one is at FUBAN 37.</p>

	<p>5. We have designed and printed our Banner, logo, festoon and stand banner to display in social gathering.</p>
	<p>6. We have distributed T-Shirt and two types of winter hats/toque as well as our 8 pages colorful Brochure / booklet, visiting card etc.</p>
	<p>7. We continuously post our group news and grant news in our Facebook groups and page.</p>
	<p>8. We have installed David and Credit card machine in our office and PayPal payment system through our website</p>
	<p>9. We have observed International Charity day on 5th September to make awareness among local and international community. <u>We also observe our anniversary day on September 26, each year.</u></p>
	<p>10. We have sponsored CAD \$100 as raffle prizes to seven Bangladeshi community picnics in Toronto.</p>



	<p>11. We have distributed booklet in public gathering for publicity among our local community and beyond our community.</p>
	<p>12. We have 3 Boards of Directors meeting in addition to our annual general meeting on December 03, 2023.</p>
	<p>13. The Free press Education Award was rewarded to Mr Ibrahim Kaskeen, Journalist Al Jazeera Television, Gaza, Palestine.</p>
	<p>14. The Grant for Water and Sanitation (Sanitation) was awarded to Davis Sunset Rotary Club, California, USA. They are building a sanitary toilet in students' dormitory in their partner organization BACHO Head Quarter Uganda, student dormitory Uganda. This grant is sponsored by <b>Rtn Kazi Alamgir Hossain, Canada.</b></p>
	<p>15. Water and Sanitation (Water) grant was rewarded to Rotary Club of Toronto Danforth, Canada for sweet water project in Khulna Bangladesh. Past President Rtn Mujibor Rahman, International Chair is the contact person for this project.</p>
	<p>16. Grant for Disease Prevention and Treatment (Mosquito net) was awarded to Rotary Club of Chittagong Sagorika, Bangladesh. They distributed 400 mosquito nets among poor people in and around the city of Chittagong.</p>

	<p>17. Grant for Disabled individuals, was awarded to Rotaract Club of Hyderabad Falcon, Pakistan. They distributed 14 wheelchairs to the disabled individuals in Hyderabad Mirpurkhas and Larknadovisions of Sindh Pakistan.</p>
	<p>18. Grant for Primary Education - Computer was awarded to Rotary Club of Kericho Kenya. They bought five used HP computers for Kaboswa Primary School. This grant was sponsored by: Mahbub Osmany Real State Team.</p>
	<p>19. Grant for Primary Education – for School Supply was awarded to Davis Sunset Rotary Club of California, USA. They provided Basic School Supplies such as school bags, stationary and simple shoes. This Grant is sponsored by Mr KausarMoni CEO, Novomed Global Inc.</p>

Grant for Economic Development – was awarded to Rotary Club of Dhaka Shining, Bangladesh.</p> <p>“The project was planned to help a small beauty parlour owner who is fighting to survive with her two children and jobless husband along with her parent in laws.
